





Communities@Work





- supermarkets, retail and commercial space.






MOLONGLO TOWN CENTRE UPDATE



Molonglo Town Centre NCDRP Advice

The 2021 concept plan:

has no consideration of indigenous site history

compromises the existing landscape character by requiring extensive cut and fill

does not accommodate enough existing mature trees

lacks an effective water management strategy

has not justified its current distribution of uses and associated densities

does not outline an effective, well integrated movement network

fails to articulate how it will deliver a safe and sustainable development, and

neglects the needs of the existing and fast-growing Molonglo Valley community.

The 2014 concept plan:

Respected the existing landscape character by minimising cut and fill


Accommodated many existing mature trees

Presented a detailed water management strategy

Clearly justified its proposed distribution of uses and associated densities

Outlined a functional and well integrated movement network
