SLA Governance

- Statutory authority under the *City Renewal Authority and Suburban Land Agency Act 2017 (CRASLA Act).*
- Report to Minister for Housing and Suburban Development
- Independent Board (Seven people, well diversified)
- The land outside the city renewal precinct, as governed by the Indicative Land Release Program (ILRP).
- On average enough land for 3,000 –
 4,000 new dwellings per year.

Whitlam – The Final Stages

- Whitlam Local Centre DA Approval 19 March 2024
- Whitlam Local Centre Sale Process June to December 2024
- Deep Creek Dam DA Approval August 2024
- Deep Creek Dam Construction March 2025 to February 2027
- Stage 4A Construction April 2024 to September 2025
- Stage 4B Construction February 2027 to August 2028
- Stage 4 Sales Events June 2024 and July 2025
- Whitlam School Opening February 2026



Whitlam's Deep Creek Dam



- Creating a large deepwater pond in Whitlam to give residents an attractive, recreational open space.
- Improving the area's stormwater management, protecting the Molonglo River from pollution and supporting future construction of roads and connections for power and water in the growing suburb.
- Adding a two-lane road and a shared pedestrian and cyclist path beside the pond, planting a selection of plants.
- Works will be noisy and dusty with noisiest works to take place in the initial few months.
- Construction will take place from early 2025 to early 2027.



Early Works Package – John Gorton Drive Intersections

- Design and Approval February 2022 to September 2024
- Construction January 2025 to December 2025

Stage One

SDP 1

- RFT, Design and Approval March 2024 to June 2025
- Land Release June 2025 to June 2026
- Estate Construction (Civil and Landscape) September 2025 to February 2027


SDP 2

- RFT, Design and Approval March 2024 to November 2026
- Land Release April 2027 to June 2030
- Estate Construction (Civil and Landscape) April 2027 to September 2028

Stage Two

- RFT, Design and Approval January 2027 to December 2028
- Land Release May 2029 to June 2033
- Estate Construction (Civil and Landscape) May 2029 to February 2031
